Contact via our website

Should you wish to engage with us via our website, we ask you provide some additional information, including your contact details so we might respond to your request. I

In each case, Barefoot Cybersecurity collects information only as necessary or appropriate to fulfil the purpose of your interaction. Barefoot Cybersecurity does not disclose personally identifying information to 3rd parties without your additional consent.

We will process and retain this information with your consent and/or whilst it is in the legitimate interests of both parties or until your consent is withdrawn.

Employees

The personal data of our employees is captured and used with the formal documents each received at the point of an offer of employment. These details are retained by Barefoot Cybersecurity for the duration of the individuals' employment and whilst it is in the legitimate interests of both parties or until consent is withdrawn.

Prospective Employees

Where personal information is willingly presented to Barefoot Cybersecurity in the form of a CV/resume. These details are retained by Barefoot Cybersecurity during the individuals'

consideration for employment and whilst it is in the legitimate interests of both parties or until constant is withdrawn.

On occasion, your personal data might be used for other communications, but only after we have your consent, or we have established a legal justification for such an activity.

Data Subject Requests
